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Sweet Spring Strawberry Bread

This bread is the perfect thing to make for your mother or to share with neighbors.

1 C. crushed strawberries (or ½ C. rhubarb & ½ C. strawberries)

1 C. sugar

1 egg

½ C. vegetable oil

1 tsp. orange zest

1 C. flour

½ tsp. baking soda

1/4 tsp. baking powder

½ tsp. cinnamon

½ tsp. salt

½ tsp. vanilla

½ C. Quick oats

Beat eggs and sugar, add oil and orange zest. Mix together dry ingredients and add uncooked Quick Oats. Fold in crushed berries and mix gently but well. Pour into a greased and floured 4x9 loaf pan.

Bake at 350 degrees for about one hour (or until a toothpick
